

Contribuição para o conhecimento da lepidopterofauna de Santa Catarina, Brasil

O objetivo do presente trabalho foi contribuir para o conhecimento da lepidopterofauna do estado de Santa Catarina, sul do Brasil, por meio de consultas às coleções científicas disponíveis no meio virtual (internet). No total, foram registradas 1156 espécies de Lepidoptera em 40 municípios do estado, pertencentes a 20 famílias, tendo se destacado Erebidae, Saturniidae e Nymphalidae. Dentre as espécies listadas, possivelmente 30 não possuíam registros publicados no estado.

Contribution to the knowledge of lepidopterofauna of Santa Catarina, Brasil

The aim of this study was to contribute for the knowledge on Lepidoptera fauna of Santa Catarina State, South of Brazil, by means of consults in scientific collections available on virtual environment (internet). In total, 1156 species of Lepidoptera were registered in 40 municipalities of Santa Catarina State, belonging to 20 families, where Erebidae, Saturniidae and Nymphalidae were the most detached. Among the species listed, possibly 30 had no published records in the state.

1. INTRODUÇÃO

As espécies de Lepidoptera, tanto noturnas quanto diurnas, são eficazes polinizadores, contribuindo em muito para a diversificação da genética florística. Sua presença ou ausência, diversidade e quantidade, podem também ser indicadores do grau de preservação ambiental, sendo seu estudo de fundamental importância no entendimento das interações ecológicas entre os diversos ambientes¹.

A ordem correspondente às borboletas e mariposas contém em torno de 160 mil espécies descritas, distribuídas em aproximadamente 124 famílias. Porém, estimativas sugerem a existência de aproximadamente 500 mil espécies. Os registros demonstram que no Brasil ocorrem em torno de 26 mil espécies distribuídas em 71 famílias¹.

Para entender a biogeografia das espécies, é necessária a realização de levantamentos e inventários, além disso, ambos são considerados base para os estudos conservacionistas². Sem seu devido conhecimento, decisões erradas podem ser tomadas quanto à conservação de ambientes³.

Apesar da diversidade de habitats, existem poucas pesquisas referentes à ordem Lepidoptera no estado de Santa Catarina. Contudo alguns inventários de Lepidoptera foram realizados recentemente, destacando-se no Oeste do estado o levantamento de Favretto et al. (2013)³, onde foi efetuado estudo bibliográfico, consultas em coleções científicas, por meio de informações digitais e observações pessoais, sendo encontradas 199 espécies para esta região. Em estudo executado por Favretto (2012)⁴, na cidade de Joaçaba foram encontradas 58 espécies, sendo que em ambos os estudos foram registrados tanto os exemplares diurnos quanto os noturnos.

Em Florianópolis, no Parque Estadual da Serra do Tabuleiro e no Parque Municipal da Lagoa do Peri foram encontradas 236 espécies de hábitos diurnos². Além de estudos de levantamento com respectiva coleta de exemplares, alguns estudos, como o de Ferro et al.

(2012)⁵, foram conduzidos através da consulta em material depositado em dez coleções brasileiras, sendo registradas 499 espécies de Arctiinae no estado de Santa Catarina. Neste mesmo sentido os estudos de Siewert et al. (2010a)⁷ e Siewert et al. (2010b)⁸ também fizeram o registro de espécies de Sphingidae e Saturniidae em diversas localidades de Santa Catarina.

Apesar de diversos pesquisadores terem realizado coletas no estado de Santa Catarina, os dados disponíveis atualmente em publicações ainda podem ser considerados escassos. Diante disso, este trabalho tem como objetivo reunir em uma lista, as espécies de Lepidoptera depositadas em coleções e museus com intuito de divulgar as espécies coletadas no estado de Santa Catarina.

2. MATERIAIS E MÉTODOS

A área de estudo é o estado de Santa Catarina, sendo que nele predominam os seguintes tipos de vegetação, Floresta Ombrófila Densa, Floresta Ombrófila Mista, Floresta Estacional Decidual, Campos Naturais e Restinga⁶.

Para encontrar os registros de Lepidoptera com ocorrência no estado de Santa Catarina foram realizadas consultas em coleções científicas que possuem sistemas de informações digitais, realizando buscas por exemplares de Lepidoptera coletados no estado de Santa Catarina, sul do Brasil. Nas seguintes coleções foram encontrados registros de Lepidoptera disponibilizados no meio digital: Insect Collection Yale Peabody Museum (YPM), Smithsonian Institution (NMNH/SI) e Field Museum. Também foram incluídos na lista do presente estudo registros feitos exclusivamente nos trabalhos de Carneiro et al. (2008)², Siewert et al. (2010a)⁷, Siewert et al. (2010b)⁸, Ferro et al. (2012)⁵, Favretto (2012)⁴ e Favretto et al. (2013)³.

3. RESULTADOS E DISCUSSÃO

Foram registradas 1156 espécies de Lepidoptera (Tabela 1), pertencentes a 20 famílias, destas as que apresentaram maior riqueza de espécies foram Erebidae (n=479), Saturniidae (n=173) e Nymphalidae (n=132). Para 30 das espécies listadas não foram encontrados registros anteriores publicados, o que levanta a possibilidade de sua presença neste trabalho ser seus registros mais recentes no estado. Estas espécies representam um aumento de 2,59% na riqueza de Lepidoptera conhecida para Santa Catarina.

Foram encontrados registros de espécies em 40 localidades de Santa Catarina, sendo que os municípios com registro de maior riqueza de espécies foram Joinville (n=373), Seara (n=351) e Florianópolis (n=293). Desta forma, a maioria dos registros ocorreu em áreas de Floresta Ombrófila Mista e Floresta Ombrófila Densa, conforme também observado por Ferro et al. (2012)⁵, demonstrando que o estado carece de estudos em áreas de campos naturais.

No presente trabalho as espécies com maior número de registros foram *Dysschema hilarina* e *Machadoia xenthosticta* (ambas com oito registros), e *Paracles variegata*, *Phaloe cruenta* e *Philoros rubriceps* (sete registros cada), todas pertencentes à família Erebidae. Além disso, 57% das espécies (n=659) tiveram apenas um registro no estado, corroborando Ferro et al. (2012)⁵ que também encontrou uma baixa quantidade de registros de um elevado percentual de espécies de seu estudo. O que segundo os mesmos autores seria um indicativo de que os esforços de estudos com Lepidoptera em Santa Catarina ainda são baixos.

4. CONCLUSÃO

No presente trabalho foi apresentada uma contribuição para o conhecimento da fauna de Lepidoptera ocorrente no estado de Santa Catarina. Apesar de diversos pesquisadores terem realizado amostragens muitas destas informações encontravam-se dispersas ou sem publicações acessíveis. Desta forma, mostrou-se que apesar de estudos recentes em alguns municípios do estado, muito ainda há para ser descoberto a respeito de sua biodiversidade, não apenas no que se refere a riqueza de espécies, mas também na distribuição destas ao longo do território de Santa Catarina.
